LOG SAWING CONTEST

9:00 PM on Strassenfest Thursday on the main stage. Event is sponsored by the Jasper DeutscherVerein and the financial sponsor is Werner Saw Mill, Inc.

This event is the longest continuous competitive event of the fest, starting at the second fest.

This event consists of two people sawing a log. The first team winning moves on to the next round.

Registration is free a few minutes before the contest, and prizes are awarded to the first and second place winners to both men's and women's divisions.

Competition has gained quite a following through the years, usually with 50-60 people sawing and 300-400 people watching. It has even become a tradition for the queen's court to saw, and I think they and everyone else has a great time. The Herald is always there covering the event. Many times making their front page.

As you know, beginning this year, Thursday night is meant to celebrate our German Heritage even more than ever before. The Deutscher Verein has been asked by the Strassenfest Committee to keep the spirit alive. Probably no bigger part of this would be using a two person saw to clear the forest. Our ancestors relied on this skill.

If you have never watched this event, come and see what you've been missing. I think you will enjoy!

Artisan and Craftsman Exchange Update

The details and planning for the Artisan and Craftsman exchange continue between the Jasper Partnership Commission in cooperation with Sister Cities of Jasper, with support from the Mayor's offices of both Jasper and Pfaffenweiler.

Eight applications were submitted by individuals interested in the exchange from Jasper. A selection committee of members from the Partnership Commission, Sister Cities of Jasper, and the Jasper Arts Commission has been formed to select the individuals to travel to Pfaffenweiler. The selected individuals will be notified later this summer.

The two selected individuals will travel to Pfaffenweiler from November 22 to December 6, 2021 to demonstrate, produce, and sell their products at various locations and at the "open air market" in Pfaffenweiler to be held November 27, 2021.

Two individuals from Pfaffenweiler will be traveling to Jasper in November 2021 to do demonstrations at the Thyen-Clark Cultural Center in Jasper. They will produce and sell their items at the special Christmas events to be held during that time as well as complete a short internship in the area. Details are being arranged as to dates for travel and hosting businesses.
