High School. Olivia completed 4 year of German language study at Jasper High School, including serving as President of the German Club her Junior and Senior year, and participation in the German Exchange Program.

Olivia is the daughter of Kurt and Jill Otto. With a GPA of 3.936, Olivia graduated in the top 25% of her class and received awards of: National Honors Society, Distinguished Service Award, and Perfect Attendance. She was also active in various clubs including: Key Club, SADD, National Honors Society, participated in band and Dance Central Academy, and volunteers at the Dubois County Humane Society. LOG SAWING CONTEST

The Deutscher Verein is sponsoring this long time event of the Strassenfest. The event is held on the Main Stage on Thursday evening at 9:00 p.m.

German Heritage Essay Contest

An essay contest open to all seniors in the four county school corporations is being held in conjunction with German-American Day on Thursday, October 6th. There are three essay topics. The students may pick one of the three topics. They are "What does German heritage mean to me?", "What can we, as the younger generation, do to help maintain and preserve our German heritage?", and "Note local or family German names as they relate to the towns or villages that immigrants came from, the meaning of the family names, relationship to geographic location, occupation, etc.".

A winner from Southridge High School, Forest Park Jr.-Sr. High School, Northeast Dubois High School, and Jasper High School will be named from the essays submitted, and the four winners will attend the German-American Day Dinner and read their winning essays.

Each winner will be awarded a \$250 scholarship. German American is the financial sponsor of the contest. Entries must be postmarked by September 3rd.
